Hello and welcome

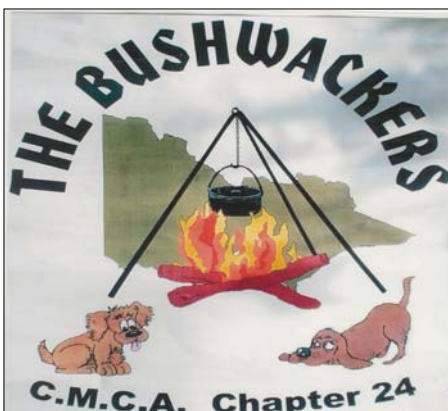
